



BEHAVIOUR ASSESSMENT IN PRIMARY 1-3

Student receive descriptive deportment/behaviour summary.

Zachowanie wzorowe - exemplary behaviour - student shows good manners, diligence and attention to detail. He/she is friendly and tolerant, easily establishes new relations, works well in a group and plays well with other children, helps others and respects his/her own property and the property of others; he/she listens carefully to the teacher and follows the rules in classroom and in the dining hall.

Zachowanie niepożądane - unwanted behaviour - the student does not follow the rules and misbehaves. He/she is not diligent and does not pay attention to the tasks. He/she has problems in maintaining good relations with peers and is not tolerant. He/she cannot play with other children and cannot work in a group. He/she does not show respect towards others' property. Does not listen to the teacher and does not follow the orders of the teacher; does not follow the rules of behaviour in classroom and in the dining hall.

RULES OF BEHAVIOUR AS AGREED WITH THE CHILDREN IN THE FORM OF A CONTRACT:

For our mutual benefit we make every effort to make our class a friendly and clean environment. We want to learn as much as we can.

- 1. During lessons we leave our place only when our teacher allows it.
- 2. If we want to say something, we raise our hand. Only one person speaks at a time.
- 3. We perform our tasks according to the teacher's instruction and we do our homework.
- 4. We care for the safety of others and our own safety: we do not push or hit others and we are especially careful on the stairs.
- 5. We respect each other: we do not offend, judge or criticise other pupils; we do not laugh at them.
- 6. We do not run on the stairs during breaks. If, during a break, we play outside, we leave school only when accompanied by a teacher.
- 7. We follow the rules of behaviour in the dining hall.
- 8. We walk in pairs.
- 9. During trips and school outings we do not leave the group without the teacher's consent.
